The Community Hub is a whole of school philosophy about supporting families so that our students reach their potential.

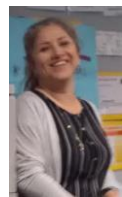
The Community Centre is open to parents and Carers from 2:30 – 3:15pm Monday – Thursday for you to come in and wait for your children. Tea and coffee is available.

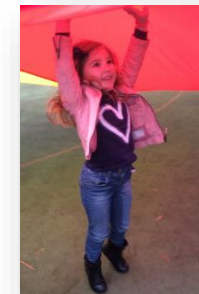
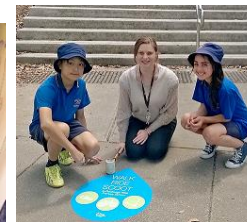
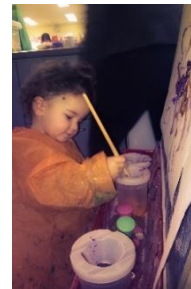

The FREE playgroups are for families with children under the age of 5 years and run every school term.

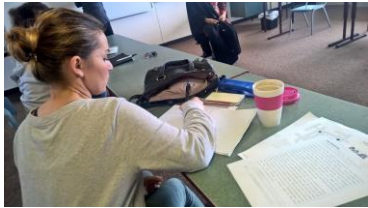
Time: 9:30am – 11:30am
